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**JOINT NOTICE OF STATUS AND STIPULATED ORDER**  
**CONTINUING FINAL APPROVAL HEARING**

WHEREAS the parties reached a class-wide settlement of this matter and on February 28, 2017, Plaintiff filed her unopposed motion for preliminary approval of the settlement;

WHEREAS on March 9, 2017, the Court entered an order granting the motion for preliminary approval;

WHEREAS in its order, the Court (1) directed the settlement administrator to timely notify the settlement class members of the settlement and their rights and (2) set a final approval hearing for November 29, 2017;

WHEREAS since this order was entered, the parties have been working to position themselves to provide the required notice. Indeed, (1) on or about May 10, 2017, the Bank forwarded the account data that Plaintiff's expert needed to determine class membership and damages, (2) Plaintiff's expert reviewed this data, determined it was incomplete and insufficient, and, on or about May 18, 2017, sought revised data, (3) Defendant cured these deficiencies and, on or about June 27, 2017, provided revised data, and (4) Plaintiff's expert is in the process of analyzing this data and estimates he can produce a list of class members with each member's damages to Defendant no later than July 24, 2017;

WHEREAS after Defendant receives this list, it will provide contact information for each class member to the settlement administrator, who will then provide notice in accordance with the notice program approved by the Court;

WHEREAS given the discrepancies in the initial data production, there is not sufficient time before the scheduled final approval hearing date of November 29, 2017, to accomplish the necessary aforementioned tasks;

WHEREAS the parties therefore request that the final approval hearing be continued to a date that is convenient for the Court and is no sooner than January 10, 2018. The parties also

respectfully request that the hearing not occur on January 23, 2018, due to a conflict of counsel;  
and

WHEREAS barring unanticipated delays, such a continuance is expected to provide the parties with the time they need to effectuate the notice program and prepare for the final approval hearing.

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:**

The final approval hearing is continued to January 10, 2018 at 2:00 p.m. All deadlines set forth in the Court's March 9, 2017 preliminary approval order shall be tied to this new final approval hearing date.
